



Dear Friends,

A noteworthy event in the July - September quarter is the presentation of the ATLAS PANTOU group in the "Golden Companies of Cyprus, from 1800 until today", an initiative of the Research Department of the Journalistic Organisation "The Phileleftheros" in collaboration with the University of Cyprus. The promotion of ATLAS PANTOU as one of the "Golden Companies of Cyprus" began with the presentation of the Group and an interview with the founder of the groups ATLAS PANTOU and ATLAS PANTON, Mr. Tonis Toumazis, on Sunday, September 19, 2021. In this interview, reference is made to the long history of the Group but also to the important timeless principles and values that govern its operation.

Another notable event of this quarter was our presentation in the special issue of the business magazine Economy Today, 'The Golden list of Real Estate'. This special edition is a multi-page, luxury edition which is dedicated to the construction/real estate sector and its key participants.

The quarter did not start well in terms of the progress of the pandemic. The cases, positivity rates and the number of patients pushed, and sometimes exceeded, the breaking point limits of the health system. Fortunately, things have been steadily improving in recent days. With the start of the school year and the fact that we are entering the winter months where contacts will be made increasingly indoors, concerns about the deterioration of the situation intensify. However, experts stress that the high rate of vaccinations, the administration of the 3rd dose and the continuous observance of protective measures, will play a decisive role in reducing the pandemic in the coming months.

In this climate of uncertainty and in combination with the unintended consequences of the closure of the naturalisation programme, the construction industry and the real estate sector, as well as other important sectors of the economy, are going through their own crisis.

Further unfavourable development, as a result of the pandemic crisis, was the significant increase, that is now recorded, in the prices of building materials not only in Cyprus but also internationally. The phenomenon of the pandemic has led to the deterioration of the international production chain, so that the increased demand on the one hand and the reduced supply on the other, have for months, led to a rise in construction materials prices, such as metal products which show an increase of about 30%, insulation/plastic materials of 13%, and electromechanical items of 11%. The recent increase in fuel costs worldwide also had a negative impact, contributing to an even greater increase in building/construction materials.

All of the above are expected to put pressure on a slowdown in construction activity. The increased construction costs, which is undoubtedly a high risk for contractors and land development professionals, are expected to lead to difficulties in starting new projects, delays in the completion of ongoing projects, possible lack of specific materials or long waiting times for their receipt, and, in certain cases, increase the need for credit extension to complete or start certain construction projects.

In order to curb the above-mentioned negative developments and to mitigate the adverse effects, the pressures on the government to accelerate public works and to set up a price observatory must be intensified.

At the company level, ATLAS PANTOU has successfully completed and delivered the private house in the Paniotis area in the village of Germasogeia in Limassol, while it succeeded to undertake, in a joint venture, the first phase of the Vasilikos - Nicosia Water project.

Finally, I would like to wish everyone a good winter, always in good health.

Limassol Del Mar, Limassol

Start date: March 2018

Project Description: Less than 25m from the beach, we have begun constructing this project, on a plot of 34,000m2 with its south side offering 170m of unobstructed sea views. Inspired by the gentle and curved waves of the Mediterranean in the south and from the low hills to the north, the unique sinusoidal curves of the project appear both in its center and on the floors with the curved walls creating a separate sculpture of approximately 40,000m2. Clearly influenced by nautical architecture, the building reflects a large cruise ship, with the outer gardens of the summit standing proudly as the bridge and the command station. The first construction phase involves the delivery of the first two towers (A and B), 13 and 18 floors respectively. The second phase involves the delivery of the apartments of the "Signature Collection", that is the eastern tower of 28 floors.

Steadily moving towards the delivery of the project, now the various works concerning the towers of the first phase along with their associated external works are concluded and delivered. Regarding the second phase, the floor slabs have been long completed and the finishing works (dry wall partition works, aluminum works, flooring installation, painting, carpentry, and sanitary installation works) are close to completion. Along with the finishing works, currently the works are also concentrated on testing and commissioning. The external works of the second phase are also progressing with a large part of them already completed.

Project Description: Project Description: Luxury high-end apartments on a 23-store tower with hotel amenities that is being developed with the latest architectural and design trends. Situated only 300m from the sea, the apartment owners can enjoy the vast amenities of the facilities that among others include incredible panoramic sea views, relaxing spa breaks, shared outdoor pool, heated indoor pool, fitness centre, tennis court, fantastic evergreen gardens surrounding the tower and spacious underground parking. **Sky Tower** rests harmoniously on the cityscape of the Limassol tourist area thanks to its magnificent design by one of London's leading architectural agencies. Moving with steady steps towards completion, all the floor slabs are long completed. The current works which include finishing works (dry wall partition works, aluminium works, floorings, carpentry, and sanitary installation works) and the project's external works are close to completion. The works regarding the tower's façade cladding with Alucobond Composite Panels (ACP) are also close to completion. All the project's works are expected to be concluded in October 2021.

The project is being developed along the beach road of Parekklisia area, in one of the most prestigious areas of Limassol. This unique high-rise building consists of only 17 luxurious apartments and a 5-floor penthouse. At road level there is a grand plaza leading to a gourmet restaurant, professional SPA, sauna, hammam, massage room, heated pool in a cave style enclosure, cigar lounge and a VIP bar for club members, wine cellar and jewellery boutique. 





Foreword by Mr. Tonis Toumazis, Founder of ATLAS PANTOU Group

As a businessman and civil engineer, I have always admired the art and science of building. Universities taught me how to methodically apply its techniques and principles, but it was my father, Panayiotis Toumazis who taught me its moral code.

Many years ago, in 1937, he established his first construction office in Famagusta. This

would be the cornerstone of the construction company that followed and the group of companies that developed later on.

The journey throughout the years has proven very challenging. The 1974 Turkish invasion inevitably affected the companies of the group, leading some of them to near closure. We lost Famagusta and our properties, yet we never lost the courage to continue, nor the ability to maintain the development of our expertise. After taking over the management of the company in 1987, with consistency, persistence and immeasurable hard work from all the personnel, we managed to transform the company into a highly regarded and well-respected aroup by the name of Atlas Pantou.

From prehistoric times to the present, the building techniques that have been adopted in Cyprus have played a major role in the development of our quality of life; they have contributed to the local population's survival, evolution and progress, even shaping our culture.
