



The professionals from the sector cannot absorb these increases, at the same time as the purchasing power, especially of the domestic market, is decreasing due to many factors such as the increase in electricity, food and fuel prices. With the cost of buying a house or an apartment rising, rental prices have also shot up. The shift towards 'green growth' is now more necessary than ever. So, there are many difficulties and challenges that we have to manage at all levels, but I am optimistic that once again we will succeed.

At the company level, ATLAS PANTOU has managed to undertake the construction of the "Neapolis" project in Limassol. It is a five-storey complex of 16 apartments with a private swimming pool.

Finally, friends and colleagues, I would like to wish you all a good summer.

Project Description: Project Description: Luxury high-end apartments on a 23-store tower with hotel amenities that is being developed with the latest architectural and design trends.

Situated only 300m from the sea, the apartment owners can enjoy the vast amenities of the facilities that among others include incredible panoramic sea views, relaxing spa breaks, shared outdoor pool, heated indoor pool, fitness centre, tennis court, fantastic evergreen gardens surrounding the tower and spacious underground parking. Sky Tower rests harmoniously on the cityscape of the Limassol tourist area thanks to its magnificent design by one of London's leading architectural agencies. This 23-store challenging project has aluminium coating all over the outside. One of the remarkable things about this construction is that the floor slabs, unlike the conventional ones, are post-tensioned. The post-tensioned slabs are designed to provide active reinforcement, making the building blocks even more efficient in terms of stability and economy in building materials. The project was practically concluded end of December 2021.

Limassol Del Mar, Limassol

Start date: March 2018

Project Description: : Less than 25m from the beach, we have begun constructing this project, on a plot of 34,000m2 with its south side offering 170m of unobstructed sea views. Inspired by the gentle and curved waves of the Mediterranean in the south and from the low hills to the north, the unique sinusoidal curves of the project appear both in its center and on the floors with the curved walls creating a separate sculpture of approximately 40,000m2. Clearly influenced by nautical architecture, the building reflects a large cruise ship, with the outer gardens of the summit standing proudly as the bridge and the command station. The first construction phase involves the delivery of the first two towers (A and B), 13 and 18 floors respectively. The second phase involves the delivery of the apartments of the "Signature Collection", that is the eastern tower of 28 floors.

Regarding the conclusion and delivery of the project, the first and second phase of the project along with the associated external works, are concluded and delivered.

Currently the works are concentrated on finishing the extra requested works on the second phase tower (easter tower).

Project Description: Luxury high-end apartments on a 23-store tower with hotel amenities. The project is being developed along the beach road of Parekklisia area, in one of the most prestigious areas of Limassol. This unique high-rise building consists of only 17 luxurious apartments and a 5-floor penthouse. At road level there is a grand plaza leading to a gourmet restaurant, professional SPA, sauna, hammam, massage room, heated pool in a cave style enclosure, cigar lounge and a VIP bar for club members, wine cellar and jewellery boutique. At this level there is also a parking for residents as well as a separate parking for restaurant and commercial area visitors and guests. On the first floor there is the entrance lobby and reception on two levels. On the grounds of the complex (about 8.000 m2) there is a half-Olympic size (25x10m) mosaic swimming pool with a bar, tennis court, park, and a playground. The project's grounds are enclosed with a secure fence, and a 24-hour video surveillance. The rest of the building consists of the following:

- 3rd and 4th floor: apartments.
- 5th floor: sauna and gym.
- 6th floor: Roman bath style heated indoor swimming pool with a bar breakfast and recreation area.
- 7th -12th floor: apartments.
- 13th floor: Sky Garden, which is part of the restaurant on the next floor.
- 14th storey: a fine dining restaurant which has a separate elevator and parking area.
- 15th -18th floor: apartments.
- 19th-23rd floor: penthouse apartment with its own elevator and a swimming pool.

Regarding the progress of works, the earthworks, the foundation works as well as the columns and slaps of the main building are long concluded. Brick and coating works are also concluded. Currently the works are concentrated on the finishing works of the tower. The works regarding the façade cladding of the tower have started. Regarding the external works and the additional structural works including the parking area slap, the structural works are concluded, and the finishing works are progressing.



Waterwork Vasilikos – Nicosia, Phase A': Construction of sub-project C1, Pipeline Nisou – Nicosia




Project Description: This important sub-project is part of the large water project Vasilikos-Nicosia which aims to transport water from the Vasilikos Desalination Unit to Nicosia and will be a second major source of water supply in the wider Nicosia area. The contract includes the installation of malleable cast iron pipelines, 800mm and 700mm in diameter and total length of 17.2KM. The works started by the highway exit towards the Kotsiatis village and already reached the area of Chalepianes. The works on Makedonias street towards the Lakatamia municipal swimming pool started. Around 5km of pipelines are already installed.

New LIDL store in Ayios Athanasios, Limassol

Start date: December 2021

Project Description: The works of the project include demolition works of all existing buildings and the construction of a new LIDL store of an internal area of around 2,200m2 with a metallic roof of around 3% inclination, external thermal facade and shading at the entrance. External works include parking spaces with shades, road and sidewalk works around the perimeter of the store, installation of the various services and the configuration of a green area/park.

Regarding the progress of works, the demolition works of existing buildings along with the substructure works of the building and the earthworks of the parking area have been concluded. Reconstruction works (ground floor slab, the columns, and the 1st floor slab) are also concluded. Currently in progress are the external works of the project with the works related to the perimeter walls of the project already completed. Regarding the works on the building, the electromechanical and insulation works are currently in progress.

The works include the construction of three main collectors for diverting rainwater to the Garylli riverbed. This is a project with an extremely high degree of difficulty, as it provides extensive excavation works on 27 streets in the center of Limassol, many of which are main commercial streets with increased traffic and commercial activity.

The works on Therissou, Vassilis Michailidis, Stavroforon, Ioustinou, Idaliou, Orfeos and Victor Hugo streets have been completed. Currently in progress are the works on Lanitis, Navarinou and Thessalonikis streets.

Foreword by Mr. Tonis Toumazis, Founder of ATLAS PANTOU Group

From cave dwelling to the first stone and timber structures, from clay to concrete and iron, man has not stopped evolving. Once, in the distant past, we gazed at the skyline from the port of ancient Salamis. Today we gaze at it from the balconies of skyscrapers, watching merchant ships, cruise ships, and hydrocarbon mining platforms plough the seas of our island.

As a businessman and civil engineer, I have always admired the art and science of building. Universities taught me how to methodically apply its techniques and principles, but it was my father, Panayiotis Toumazis who taught me its moral code.

Many years ago, in 1937, he established his first construction office in Famagusta. This

would be the cornerstone of the construction company that followed and the group of companies that developed later on.

The journey throughout the years has proven very challenging. The 1974 Turkish invasion inevitably affected the companies of the group, leading some of them to near closure. We lost Famagusta and our properties, yet we never lost the courage to continue, nor the ability to maintain the development of our expertise. After taking over the management of the company in 1987, with consistency, persistence and immeasurable hard work from all the personnel, we managed to transform the company into a highly regarded and well-respected aroup by the name of Atlas Pantou.

From prehistoric times to the present, the building techniques that have been adopted in Cyprus have played a major role in the development of our quality of life; they have contributed to the local population's survival, evolution and progress, even shaping our culture.


